FAMOUS FOLKS BURIED IN EVERGREEN THE BARNETTS

William D. Barnett came to Jacksonville in 1878 to operate a furniture store. His father, William B. Barnett was a wealthy businessman from Kansas looking for new challenges. After visiting his son, he moved his wife here & opened the Jacksonville National Bank. Bion H. Barnett left college before graduating & joined his father as a clerk. They were the only two employees. Soon, it became the largest bank in Florida. William D. sold his furniture store and joined the bank as did several succeeding generations of Barnetts. Great-grandson, William R. Barnett and great-great grandson, William B. Barnett, generously served on Evergreen's Board of Trustees from 1945 to 2006.
